## All patterns are written in standard American terms. Here is an easy conversion chart for UK crochet terms:

US Terms	UK terms
sl st (slip stitch)	sc (single crochet)
sc (single crochet)	dc (double crochet)
dc (double crochet)	tr (treble crochet)
skip	miss

**Materials:** Sample blanket used approx. 11 skeins or 5,200 metres of Moda Vera Marvel Plain 5ply acrylic yarn and crochet hook size H (5.0 mm).

Gauge: You may work to your own gauge.

**Finished Size:** You may customize the size of this blanket to any length and width. Sample blanket measured approx. 40" square.

## **Special Stitches:**

**Sc Shell:** (Sc, ch 3, sc) all in same loop.

**5-dc Shell:** [(Dc, ch 1) 4 times, dc] all in same loop.

Blanket: (See close up photos of stitch rows on next page.)

Row 1: Make a row of loops as follows: (Ch 3, dc in 3<sup>rd</sup> ch from hook) repeat until blanket reaches desired width. *Ensure you have an odd # of loops.* Turn. (Sample blanket started with 45 loops.)

Row 2: **5-dc shell** in 1<sup>st</sup> loop, (**sc shell** in next loop, **5-dc shell** in next loop) across. Turn.

Row 3: Fold 5-dc shell toward you, sc shell in loop at base of 5-dc shell, (sc shell in next ch-3 loop, fold next 5-dc shell toward you, sc shell in loop at base of 5-dc shell) across. Turn.

Row 4: Sc shell in 1st ch-3 loop, (5-dc shell in next ch-3 loop, sc shell in next ch-3 loop) across. Turn.

Row 5: Sc shell in next ch-3 loop, (fold next 5-dc shell toward you, sc shell in loop at base of 5-dc shell, sc shell in next ch-3 loop) across. Turn.

Row 6: 5-dc shell in 1<sup>st</sup> ch-3 loop, (sc shell in next ch-3 loop, 5-dc in next ch-3 loop) across. Turn.

Remaining rows: Repeat rows 3-6 until blanket reaches desired length.

Fasten off.
